### Safeguarding at Bunwell

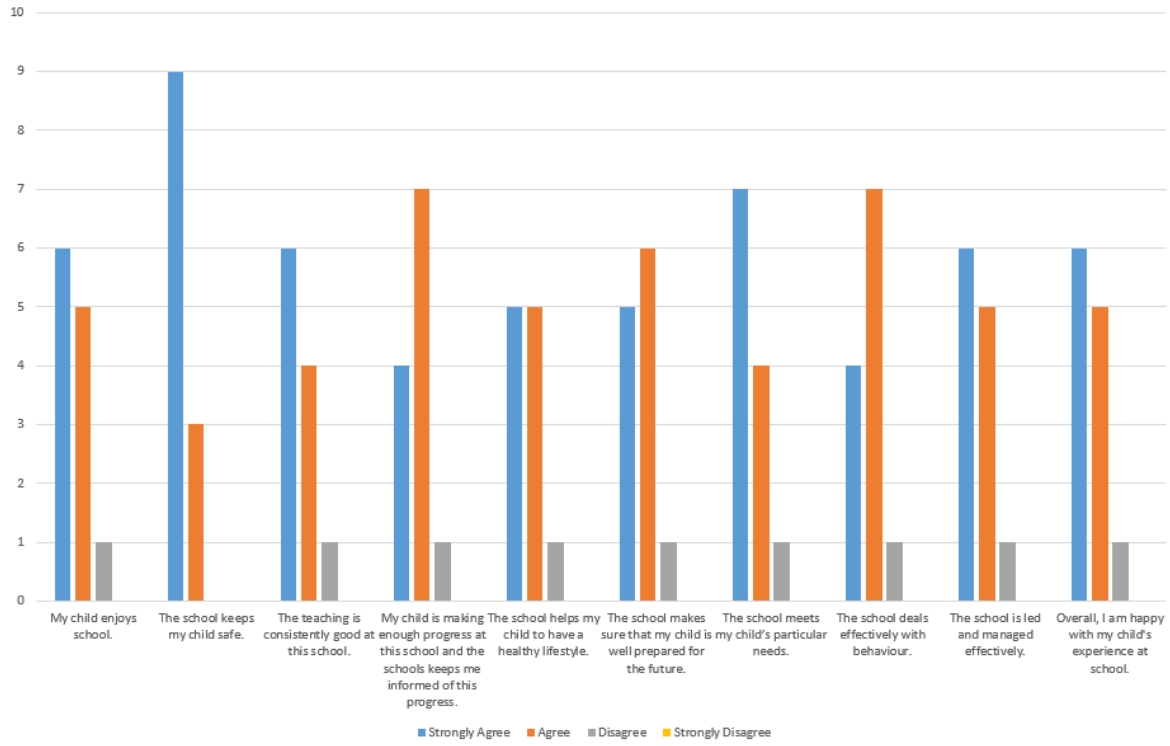

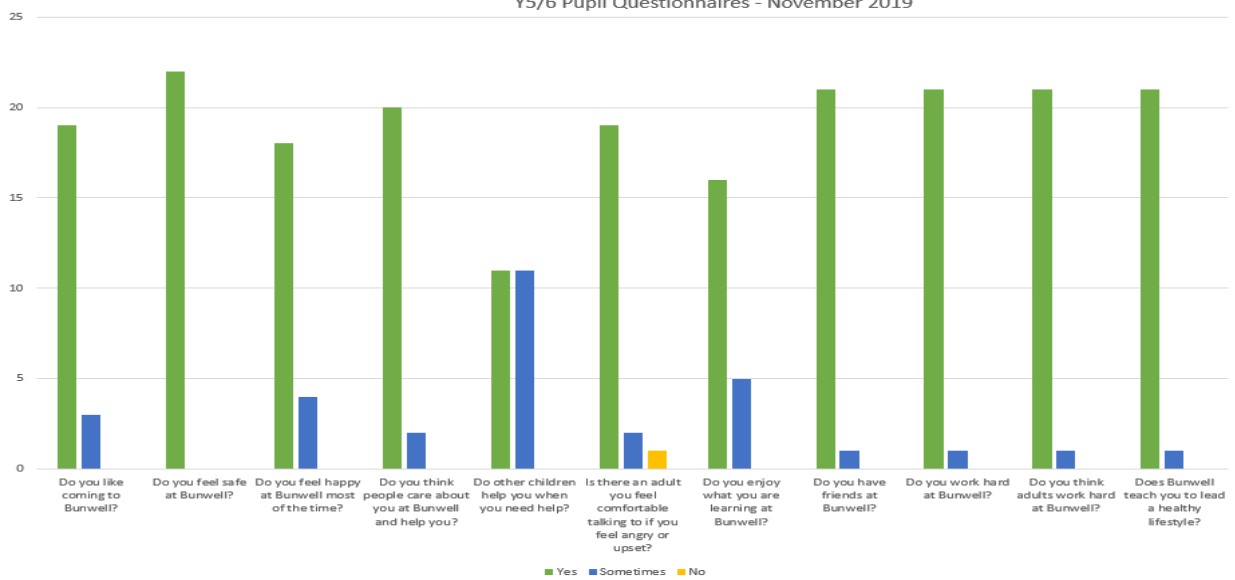
## Headteacher News

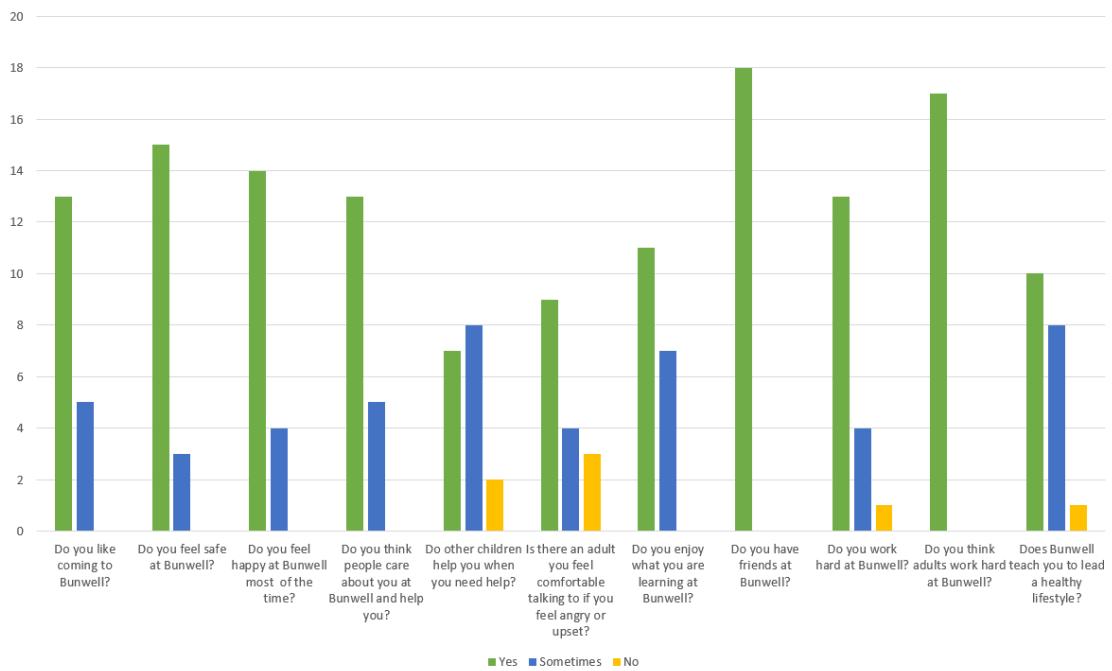
Parent Questionnaire - November 2019



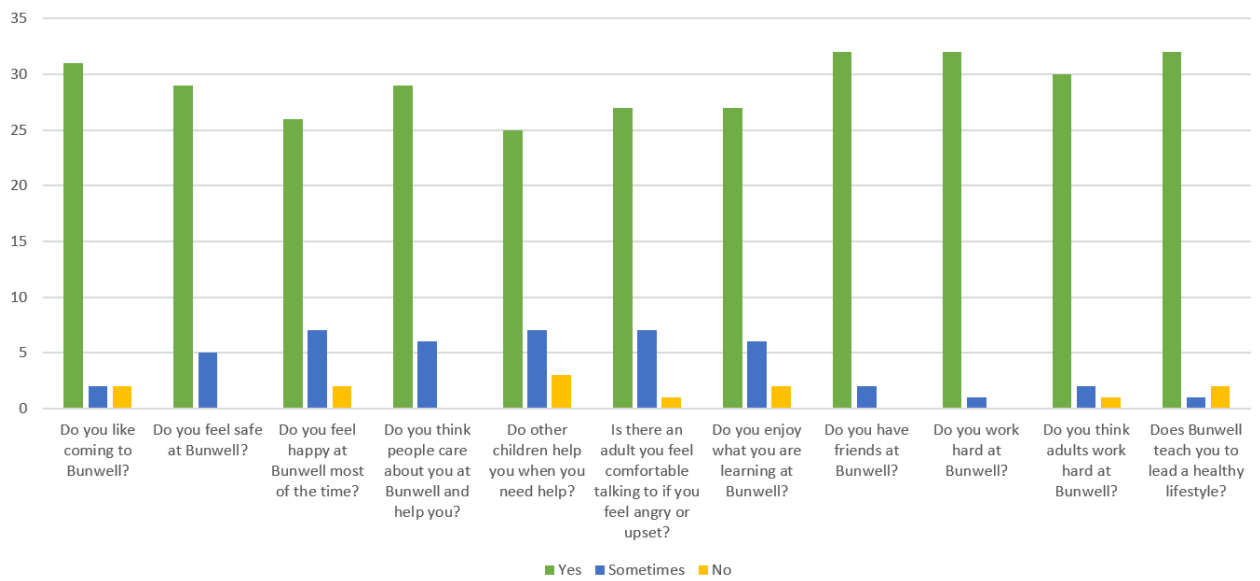
Y5/6 Pupil Questionnaires - November 2019
