### Hedgehogs Class - Autumn 2023

Subject	What we will be learning	How you can help at home
English	Sentence structure, handwriting and comprehension skills. We will be developing our retrieval skills with Whole Class Reading lessons using Handa's Surprise and Owl Babies. Our Write Stuff lessons this term will focus on The Last Train Ride.	Listen to your child read daily. Reading books need to be brought to school everyday even if they do not need changing. Support your child with writing simple sentences.
Maths	Place value and addition and subtraction – this term we will be developing our understanding of place value and looking at how to use this knowledge to support our work on addition and subtraction.	Practising times tables for children in Y2 and number bonds to 10/20 for children in Y1.
Science	Our science topic for the first half term is materials, we will be describing materials and thinking about their everyday uses.	Discuss with your child what they have learned and look at BBC Bitesize for different videos and fun activities that you could do together. Start to discuss materials and their uses, you could make some models
Topic	Our topic in History and Geography is Seasides, we will be thinking about the features of seaside towns, both physical and human. We will then start to consider how seaside holidays have changed over time.	Take a trip to the seaside and discover some of the features that you see, take pictures and collect artefacts to show the class.
Art/DT	We will be learning about and creating abstract art, initially we will be exploring shape and colour in the lessons.	Encourage your child to practise the new skills they have learnt. You take a trip to the Sainsburys Centre.
PSHE	The first topic we will be doing in PSHE this term is 'Being Me in My World'. We will be learning about our rights and responsibilities.	Begin to discuss our rights and responsibilities at home as well as in the wider community.
RE	In RE we are learning about Leaders and Teachers, the children will consider leaders in school and the wider community as well as what makes a good leader.	Take a trip to a place of worship and discuss some of the artefacts that you can see.
PE	PE will be on a <b>Monday</b> this year, please ensure kit is in for then. This term we will be doing yoga, team building, fundamentals and gymnastics (at the hall).	You could consider our Club Links document and try some different sports outside of school. Alternatively, you could try some sports at the park!
